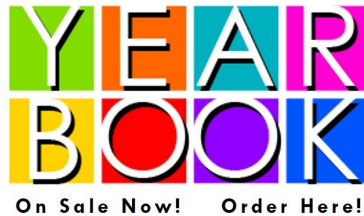

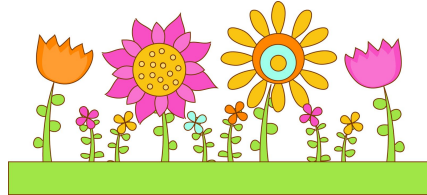

Sunset Ranch Learning Center Garden

Through our Learning Center Garden we hope to promote nutrition education, physical activity and relationships within our neighborhoods that will sustain for years to come. As we work toward building a healthier community, our ambition is to continue to develop the Learning Center Garden site and programs that will benefit the community. Toward this goal we are approaching families to aid in the underwriting of this event either financially or with in-kind donations. Specifically, we are seeking donations for our Learning Center Garden of the following:

- seeds (for winter garden and for spring garden) and starter plants/herbs.
- bark or gravel for walkways.
- woven polypropylene weed barrier fabric.
- small watering cans for kids (30) enough for one class.
- baskets for collecting veggies (5).
- mouse traps.
- composter and/or worms for soil.
- soil.
- yard waste container with wheels for moving garden weeds.
- small wooden stakes for making garden signs.
- plants (climbing plants for the fence, bulbs, herbs, hardy sun loving plants perennials, perennial flowers, marigolds for veggie beds)

Are You a Bike or Scooter Rider?

If so, thank you! Riding or scooting provides exercise and reduces traffic at Sunset Ranch!
In order to keep everyone safe, please remember the following:

1. **ALWAYS WEAR A HELMET.** It is the law for a reason. I have personally watched students fall off bikes and scooters and hit their heads on the street. Without a helmet, this could be devastating.
2. **WALK YOUR BIKES/SCOOTERS ACROSS INTERSECTIONS AND ON SCHOOL GROUNDS.** Again, better safe than sorry. With lots of cars and pedestrians, walking wheeled

transportation will protect everyone.

Parents, don't forget that what you model for your children is important. They will follow your lead. #1 and #2 are for you as well as your students!
