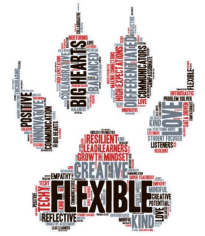

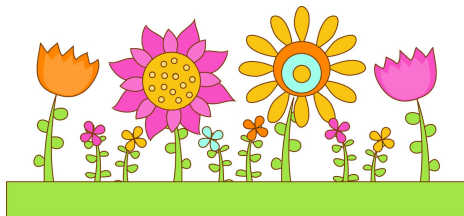

Each year, Sunset Ranch convenes a School Site Council of teachers, parents, and staff members. The School Site Council (SSC) is responsible for the drafting and approval of the Single School Plan for Student Achievement (SPSA) which supports the mission and vision of the school and addresses the learning needs of students and the community. The SSC also weighs in on important school decisions and helps determine where certain monies are spent and which extracurricular programs to continue or pursue. It is an important part of school governance and a forum for all stakeholders to give input. The state SSC bylaws require five parents to be on the council, each serving a two year term. **This year we have five openings on the SSC that will be open for election.** The meetings will be held on 9/21, 10/26, 2/1, and 5/10 at 3:00 p.m. The meetings typically run until 4:30 p.m.

If there are more than five candidates, the bios will be included on a ballot that will go out to all Sunset Ranch families for a vote.
