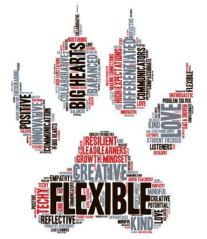

This past week we approved our School Safety Plan at School Site Council. **One new program/curriculum we will be implementing beginning February 26th is a bullying education and prevention curriculum for ALL students.** The curriculum endorsed by Placer County and aligned with our current Positive Behavior Intervention Support (PBIS) system will teach students how to prevent and proactively deal with bullying situations at school. I will be sharing more extensive information with you in the Howling Coyote for the Week of 2/26. Our hope is that you will also have conversations about the curriculum at home so that we can get all students and families on the same page about this important issue. Together, we can give students the information and tools to eradicate this issue at Sunset Ranch.

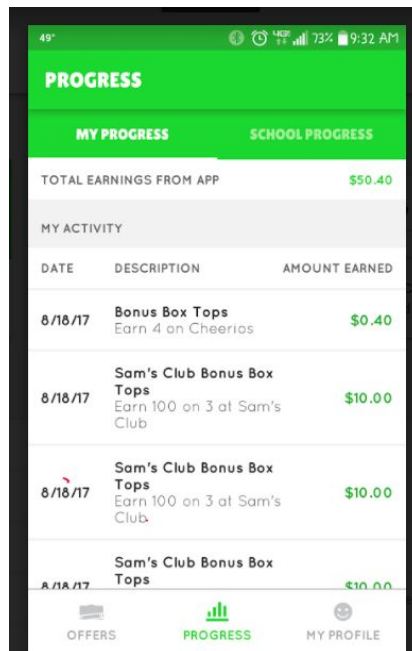


Box Top Collection Week is here!
