Technology, when utilized safely and appropriately in the classroom, can accelerate and extend student learning. Moreover, our goal is to best prepare students to actively participate in the 21st century world and technology skills and digital literacy are critical components of this education.

At this time, Sunset Ranch will be supporting a BYOD program that includes Chromebooks and other laptop computers. Smartphone use during the instructional day will continue to be prohibited as they can utilize an outside network that is not under the district firewall/control. Smartphones can be used before and after school but must be stored in student backpacks during the instructional day. Students bringing supported devices to school will utilize the school "BYOD" network to access the internet. In this environment, they will be protected under the district firewall and we will have the ability to monitor their use of the technology.
